

## About the show

This is our sixth annual regional judged art show. It is open to the **first 100 pieces entered—up to two pieces per artist. The entry fee is \$20 for the first piece; \$10 additional for a second piece.** Each artist may also bring three well-matted bin pieces for sale (not judged). The commission on sales is 40% with a portion of each sale going to the Artists' Guild. Commissions apply to sales up to 30 days after the show if they are a direct result of this exhibit.

Cash prizes totaling approximately **\$1,000** will be given at the judge's discretion, plus a People's Choice award, decided by votes of visitors to the show. Photography will be judged separately.

The Guild supports a Second Friday Art Walk where artists display their work in the galleries and shops in town. Our opening reception will be during the Art Walk, affording an opportunity to stroll around town, see other art shows, and perhaps have a meal in a local restaurant.

### Our Judge: Kathryn Willis

Kathryn Willis has viewed, studied, and written about art for forty years. From 1990 to 2000, she served as the art critic for the Fredericksburg Freelance-Star, and continues to write feature articles about arts and cultural topics for that paper and other regional publications. Her articles have received numerous press awards, including three state first place awards from the Virginia Presswomen's Assn. From 1996 to 2006, Willis served on the board of Virginians for the Arts, the statewide arts advocacy body aligned with the Virginia Commission for the Arts, as well as the Steering Committee for the 2000 Governor's Awards for the Arts. A lifelong advocate for the arts, she has followed the careers of regional artists for decades, and has traveled extensively to view art exhibitions both nationally and abroad. She is a founding member of the Virginia Assn of Local Arts Agencies, as well as of the Arts & Cultural Council of the Rappahannock. Willis double majored in French and Art History at then-Mary Washington College; holds a master's from Va. Tech, and professional certification in advanced public relations from George Washington University. In addition to serving as Director of the Arts Council, Willis teaches composition and literature at Germanna Community College in Fredericksburg.

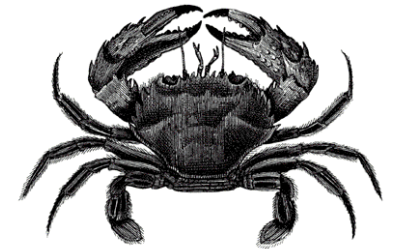

## Rules:

We accept the first 100 pieces (not artists) registered. Entries and fees over that will be returned. Show is not juried but is judged for awards after hanging.

Artwork is to be delivered and picked up in person or by your representative, with signed note from artist for pick up.

Original 2D or 3D artwork only—some examples: oil, acrylic, water media, hand-pulled prints, drawing media, pastel, photography, clay, glass, fiber, sculpture.

Artists entering 3D work may need to provide display stand. Please call before delivery date.

Wall pieces may be no larger than 36" on a side, including frame.

No replicas of the work of others permitted. Please, no work previously entered in this show.

All work must be for sale.

Nudes and sexually explicit themes excluded.

Framing that is not secure is not safe for hanging and will not be accepted. Must have hanging wire on reverse—no saw-tooth hangers.

Paint must be dry.

Please put artist's name, title of work, price, and medium on the back of each piece.

By signing and submitting the entry form, I acknowledge that I am aware that all work must comply with show rules and understand the show committee has the right to reject any work that does not comply. I also understand that entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-accepted basis and that those over the first 100 pieces will be returned (with fees). The show does not insure artwork, but does take reasonable care to protect it. I will not hold the Colonial Beach Artists' Guild or JarrettThor Fine Arts responsible or liable for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever. I understand that a fee of \$5 per day will be assessed if my work is not picked up on time, or other arrangements made.

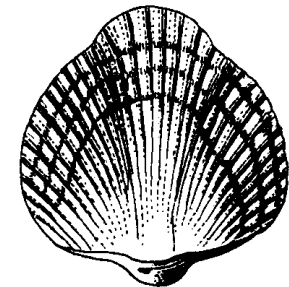
