You will learn the basic stitches of bead embroidery. No beadwork experience required.



Here is a great chance to practice some beaded embroidery skills, learn new stitches, make up a few stitches if necessary and use only the beads that speak to you. There are very few rules- the most important being to create something that you love and will enjoy wearing. We will use metal zippers as decorative elements to form the basis of YOUR design and then use seed beads and other favorite beads, buttons and found objects to fill in the open spaces.

Students will supply their own beads A list of resources will also be supplied

The instructor will provide a basic kit that includes needles. Ultrasuede, metal cuff form and thread. **The basic kit fee is \$18.00, payable to the instructor at start of class.**
